## RiverWinds<sup>SM</sup>-The Right Choice

The RiverWinds project is located two miles west of Worthington, MN, on Buffalo Ridge, an area with a consistent wind resource. Missouri River Energy Services operates two 900 kW and two 950 kW turbines on behalf of its member utilities. Operation began in July 2002.

The electricity that you purchase will be generated on your behalf by the RiverWinds turbines and injected into the regional electric transmission system.

Wind power is sold in 100 kilowatt-hour blocks. You decide how much wind energy you want to buy, in addition to your traditional energy purchase.
